+ The slideshows provide immediate feedback. The morpheme is shown, students have time to say the meaning, then the meaning appears. Begin the slideshow and the slides transition automatically.

We couldn't put the PowerPoint slideshow in the preview, so this is a screen shot of the first set. The morpheme (in red) on each card appears first, I left enough time for students to answer, then the meaning (in black) appears. The slide automatically transitions to the next slide and repeats above. Very cool!
